The question on the Yerushalmi is obvious: the Beis Hamikdash wasn't the home of the Kohen Gadol- it was the home of Hahakdosh Baruch Hu? Its easy to understand that you don't walk in to someone else's house without thocking but can we learn from there someone else's house without knocking- but can we learn from there that in your own house the same rule would apply? From here we see that it is wrong to think of the Beis Hamikdash as Hashem's house. the Gemara is teaching us that the Beis Hamikdash is our house. That which exists here in this world, is ours. By building the Beis Hamikdash, we are inviting Hakadosh Baruch Hu to live in our house. Baruch Hu to live in our house.
Therefore, there is an exact paralllel between the Kohen Gadol, as representative of the people, walking in to the Beis Hamikdash, and anybody walking in to their own house.
